

Statement on California Proposition 65

California Proposition 65, the California Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act of 1986, is intended to protect drinking water sources from chemicals known to cause cancer, birth defects or other reproductive harm, and to inform citizens about possible exposures to such chemicals.

NXP has reviewed and considered the substance list (with latest update of January 3, 2025) of the California Proposition 65 regulation. Having evaluated supplier certifications and material composition declarations, NXP has determined, to the best of its knowledge and belief, that:

- NXP products may contain one or more of the substances registered on this substance list. Information regarding substances contained may be found in NXP product composition declarations.
- NXP products are not intended to cause consumer exposure to any contained substances during normal product use.
