

## CERTIFICATE OF COMPLIANCE - ODC Declaration -

The Montreal Protocol on Substances that Deplent the Ozone Layer (the "Montreal Protocol") sets out a mandatory timetable for the phase out of Ozone Depleting Chemicals (ODCs). NXP is aware that each country in which we manufacture NXP Semiconductor Products has ratified, or otherwise complies with, the Montreal Protocol through local legislation such as (EC) No. 1005/2009, (EU) 2024/590, or the U.S. Clean Air Act.

We hereby certify that, to the best of our knowledge, NXP has not used any ODCs in the manufacturing of any products sold to our customers since 2007. This certification applies to all of the manufacturing locations of NXP B.V. and its subsidiaries and affiliated companies<sup>1</sup>. In addition, we also certify that NXP semiconductor products do not contain any ODCs.
